## Bills

1. **H.R. 2681** - Prevents EPA from regulating cement kilns emissions, the third largest source of mercury in the nation.
2. **H.R. 2401** - Prevents EPA from actively reducing smog and other pollutants emitted from power plants pollutants.
3. **H.R. 2018** - Overturns the Clean Water Act by limiting EPA protections that have safeguarded our water for decades.
4. **H.R. 910** - Prevents EPA from actively reducing pollutants that are known to contribute to global climate change.
5. **H.R. 1** - Major financial cuts to many programs that provide clean water and clean air protections nationwide.
6. **H.R. 1**, McKinley Amendment #1 - Forbids EPA from citing "unacceptable adverse effects" under the Clean Water Act.
7. **H.R. 1**, McKinley Amendment #2 - Blocks rulemaking of coal ash waste disposal, including metals like arsenic and lead.
8. **H.R. 1**, Griffith Amendment - Denies EPA from using science when analyzing impacts of mountaintop removal mining.
9. **H.R. 1**, Johnson Amendment - Denies pollution protection for streams from contamination as a result of coal mining.
10. **H.R. 1**, Goddlatte Amendment - Prevents resources from being used to protect the Chesapeake Bay watershed.
11. **H.R. 1**, Rooney Amendment - Blocks EPA regulation of dangerous nutrient pollutants like nitrogen and phosphorous.
12. **H.R. 1**, Noem Amendment - Blocks EPA from updating health standards.
